Majors:	[in Spanish] Business, Communication, Design, Education, Health, Psychology, Social Sciences, Performing Arts. Students also have access to courses for exchange students, including Spanish Language, Uruguayan Culture, Uruguayan Literature, History of Uruguay, Latin American Thinking, and Community Service Learning
Note:	Like many South American institutions, UCU has a historical Catholic/Jesuit affiliation. Curriculum is secular with NO religious expectations of exchange students.
Language requirement?	Equivalent of B1 Spanish . Students with A2 Spanish may apply, provided they also enroll in the pre-semester Spanish immersion course.
Housing:	Housing guidance is given for finding rooms to rent or shared apartments Approx. \$400-600/monthly
Scholarships:	Gilman Scholarship [national]
